Austin's *How to Do Things with Words* and Émile Benveniste's definition of the performative as a form of speaking in which the act of speech creates its own referent. The book moves on to consider the larger place of performativity within *De rerum natura*, and the poem's insight on the acts of promising and naming. Bridging critical theory and ancient philosophy, *The Language of Atoms* will engage scholars in a host of humanities disciplines, including Classics, Philosophy, and Comparative Literature.
